

## City of Huntington Specifications for Mowing and Lawn Care

1. **2109 water plant 1211 N. 8<sup>th</sup> St.:** everything inside fence and at least 6' outside of fence; trim fence area and around all structures inside fence
2. **Sewer plant 1110 Lowery Sawmill Rd.:** everything inside fence; trim all structures and concrete drive areas inside and outside fence; mow as closely to pond as possible; City will mow inward slope of pond. DO NOT mow or trim inside drying beds. Clean off concrete when finished.
3. **City Hall 802 S. Hwy 69:** mow/trim everything, including ditch areas; clean flower beds; clean off all concrete; trim all hedges and rose bushes as specified by City Administrator
4. **Fire station 122 E. Preston:** mow/trim everything; trim and clean concrete areas
5. **Utility yard and shop 201 S. Main – includes old Police Dept. building and old Public Works bldg. at corner of Franklin and 1669:** mow/trim everything inside/outside fenced area and ditches and around all structures
6. **Fuller Springs Water Plant 1950 Old Homer Alto Rd:** mow/trim everything inside/outside fence and ditch; mow 6' area around outside fence; trim to edge of water
7. **Fuller Springs Remote Well 1179 Old Alto Rd:** mow/trim inside/outside fence and around all structures
8. **Civic Center 1179 Hwy 69:** mow/trim all property/ditches/shrubs and around all structures, including Flag Memorial; clean off concrete areas (VITAL TO KEEP MEMORIAL AREA TRIMMED AND NEAT)
9. **Water well:** Hwy 69 across from City Hall: mow/trim inside fence and 6' outside fence, plus area in front of well to edge of highway
10. **Welcome to Huntington signs at both ends of town on Hwy 69:** mow and trim
11. **Centennial Park:** mow; trim; trim trees as specified by City Administrator or Public Works Director; clean flower beds
12. **Youth softball complex across from Centennial Park:** mow and trim everything between Main Street and 6<sup>th</sup> Street, including both softball fields

### NOTE:

Pick up all limbs, brush, and trash from each location and haul off.

All areas need to be mowed once every 2 weeks (or additionally as specified by the City Administrator).

The City Administrator or Public Works Director may require additional work done due to special functions. Notification will be given as soon as possible when the need arises.

Work is to be paid for as agreed upon between the City Administrator and Contractor.
