Specifications for Mowing and Lawn Care

1. City Hall- 802 S. Hwy 69: mow/trim everything, including ditch area; clean flower beds; clean off all concrete; trim all hedges, (front & back of building), and rose bushes as specified by City Administrator
2. utility yard and shop -201 S. Main – includes old Police Dept. building and Public Works bldg. at corner of Franklin and 1669 (Main St.): mow/trim everything inside/outside fenced area and ditches, including around all structures
3. Civic Center-1179 Hwy 69: mow/trim all property/ditches/shrubs and around all structures, including Flag Memorial; clean off concrete areas (VITAL TO KEEP MEMORIAL AREA TRIMMED AND NEAT)
4. water well- Hwy 69 across from City Hall: mow/trim inside fence and 6' outside fence, plus area in front of well to edge of highway
5. Welcome to Huntington signs at both ends of town on Hwy 69: mow and trim
6. Centennial Park-Main Street: mow; trim; trim trees as specified by City Administrator or Public Works Director; clean flower beds
7. youth softball complex across from Centennial Park-Main Street: mow and trim everything between sidewalk by concession stand and 6th Street, including both softball fields

NOTE:

Pick up all limbs, brush, and trash from each location and haul off *at each mowing*.

All areas need to be mowed once every 2 weeks (or additionally as specified by the City Administrator).

The City Administrator or Public Works Director may require additional work done due to special functions. Notification will be given as soon as possible when the need arises. *Contractor will be compensated for additional work.*

Work is to be paid for as agreed upon between the City Administrator and Contractor.
